


Team Personnel Homework



Codes of Conduct

- The purpose of the Saskatoon Youth Soccer Inc. Code of Conduct and Ethics...is to ensure a safe and positive environment...by making individuals aware that there is an expectation, at all times, of appropriate behaviour consistent with Saskatoon Youth Soccer Inc.'s core values. Saskatoon Youth Soccer Inc. supports equal opportunity, prohibits discriminatory practices, and is committed to providing an environment in which all individuals are treated with respect

The Rule of Two serves to protect minor athletes in potentially vulnerable situations by ensuring that more than one adult is present

The Rule of Two states that there will always be two screened and Respect in Sport and NCCP trained or certified coaches with an athlete, especially a minor athlete, when in a potentially vulnerable situation



PLAYER SAFETY

Guidelines for Interacting with Children & Adolescents

- When taking on the responsibilities of the role of the coach you are also taking on a position of trust for the athlete.
- This trust us built on boundaries of professionalism inherent in the coach and athlete relationship.
- The responsibility of maintaining the professional relationship and appropriate boundaries always lies with the adult.



PLAYER SAFETY

Reporting Abuse or Misconduct

• There is a legal and ethical responsibility to act, when a person becomes aware that a child may be or has been abused.
