

    - Final matches (1st vs 2nd) for the U13-U19 Alliance and City Leagues will be held the weekend of June 22-23, 2024

• Unless otherwise determined by SYSI, ALL U5-U9 games and practices are up to the coach and/or zone technical director discretion and any cancellations shall be coordinated between the teams. SYSI does not reschedule U5-U9 games, however teams may do so on an alternate field/date.

### U11-U19 Youth Games

 Unless otherwise determined by SYSI, all youth U11-U19 games are on as scheduled and shall be up to referee discretion. Teams are to arrive at their scheduled game or risk forfeit fines.

# FIELD START TIMES

## **Scheduled Start Times**

- If games are running late, the half time break shall be cut short first and then the halves (depending on how late you are running). Team can find an available green space to warm-up/stretch as you are waiting to get on the field.
- Teams and their equipment shall be off the field as soon as possible after the final whistle to allow for the next teams to set up for their scheduled game.



# **U7 & U9 Festival Format**

- U7 and U9 D League teams will be playing festival format games.
- 2 games per game night.
- Set up:
  - teams will set up equipment (cones and nets as needed) for their first game of the evening, leave their equipment in place for the second game, and come back to collect the equipment after the conclusion of this game.



The Rule of Two serves to protect minor athletes in potentially vulnerable situations by ensuring that more than one adult is present

The Rule of Two states that there will always be two screened and Respect in Sport and NCCP trained or certified coaches with an athlete, especially a minor athlete, when in a potentially vulnerable situation



## PLAYER SAFETY

**Guidelines for Interacting with Children & Adolescents** 

- When taking on the responsibilities of the role of the coach you are also taking on a position of trust for the athlete.
- This trust us built on boundaries of professionalism inherent in the coach and athlete relationship.
- The responsibility of maintaining the professional relationship and appropriate boundaries always lies with the adult.



# PLAYER SAFETY

**Reporting Abuse or Misconduct** 

 There is a legal and ethical responsibility to act, when a person becomes aware that a child may be or has been abused.

# REFERES Referees (U11-U19)

- No Referee Games without a referee for whatever reason must get played or both teams forfeit. If a referee does not show up the HOME TEAM will email, operations@saskatoonyouthsoccer.ca, the game sheet to the SYSI office!
- Field Marshall Program Each team in U11-U19 must name their Field Marshall and have that person sign the game sheet. The Field Marshall is to stay in the spectator area to help alleviate any spectators from abusing referees.
- Mentorship SYSI encourages all teams to fill out the online <u>Referee Evaluation Form</u> and not only when you have a complaint. Referees need encouragement too!



## **GAME SHEETS**

**Game Sheet Procedures (U11-U19)** 

- It is the responsibility of the Home team to provide the game sheet for any grass field games, but the game sheet will be supplied to the teams if the games are at the Saskatoon Sports Centre. The game sheet can be collected at SSCI Guest Services.
- The game sheet & game score will be inputted by referee within 48 hours. Teams should take a photo of the game sheet in the event SYSI requests a copy.
- <u>Please be patient</u> because we do not always receive the game sheets on time.

- Team personnel must review the game sheet prior to the start of the game and ensure the game sheet is accurate;
- The chart above is the SYSI game sheet infractions guideline. The chart lists minimum actions that will be imposed; however the SYSI office may impose an alternate penalty.



## 5 UP - 1 UP RULE 5 up - 1 up (U11 ONLY)

- 5 up 1 up (under-11):
  - If the game gets to a 5-goal differential the trailing team can add a player, and every 3 goals after, you can add an additional player up to a maximum of 3 additional players. If the score goes under the 5-goal differential, they must remove the additional player
