About SYSI:

Established in 1984, Saskatoon Youth Soccer Inc. (SYSI) is a non-profit organization which manages and operates soccer leagues for ages four to 19 in Saskatoon for both indoor and outdoor seasons. We organize several tournaments and jamborees as well as host one indoor provincial competition annually. SYSI has a small office team of four people who coordinate and manage the league operations along with countless volunteers who assist in registration, evaluations, team formation, coach recruitment, and team management for each of our five geographical zones and over 36 community associations in the city. Our Zone members administer U7 and U9 development leagues as well as U11 to U19 leagues in several skill divisions and our Community Association members administer U5 to U9 age groups. SYSI reports to a volunteer Board of Directors and are accountable to the provincial sport governing body, Saskatchewan Soccer Association.

OUR MISSION is to create the culture and opportunity for every child to enjoy participating in soccer.

Mini SISCO is one of the largest indoor mini soccer sporting events in the province taking place in March each year with an average of 140 teams taking part making up 1,400 players between the ages of four



and eight plus an additional 4,200 parents, grandparents, siblings, etc. spectating the event!

This event is the largest organized indoor mini soccer event each year with all teams receiving three games each throughout the weekend and all players receiving a gold medal! The event takes place at the Saskatoon Sports Centre with

12 mini pitches or games happening at any given hour!
