Kids In the Park & Dream League All-Abilities & Parent-Tot

WHAT: Kids In the Park: A free drop-in citywide travelling summer soccer program aimed at ages 4 to 12. Eliminates barriers by bringing the program to the children in their neighborhood parks. Children gain positive experiences, make new friends, stay active, and get outdoors while playing soccer.

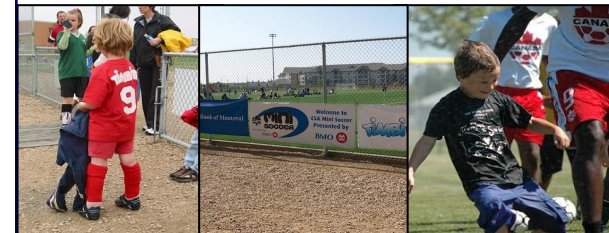
