MANDATE

1. To provide an opportunity for everyone to play at the provincial event at the level they are competitive at.
2. To build an event that show cases our great sport to everyone in the province.
3. To centralize the event having our lacrosse community all together.

SLA RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Notify all teams and associations in Saskatchewan of the event.
2. Collect MA/AMA bonds that will be held year after year \$1000 Bond for all or \$200 per division. SLA to send out May 1st to confirm MA/AMA are participating in a division once bond is paid it stays with SLA until the MA/AMA no longer is playing in the provincials or if MA/AMA no longer participating in the box sector. (SLA can plan for payments)
3. to provide website for the event
4. to provide stats site for the event and history
5. to provide website registration for tournament
6. to provide team site registration
7. to collect all registration fees for the event
8. to provide Facebook and all other kinds of social media SLA will also do advertising for the event in cooperation with the host.
9. All sponsorship and advertising must be approved by the SLA.
10. to provide a basic marketing plan with packages that host can use for sponsorships.
11. to provide convenors for the event
12. to provide RIC's and officials for the event
13. to provide all possible grants
14. to provide posters, banners, and flyers for the event
15. pay all bills for rooms, officials, facilities, and peridium's after all invoices are paid the profits will be spilt even with the host community and box sector provincial's fund.
16. to provide the banners, medals, MVP awards, and All-Star awards.
17. Provide Clocks and nets
18. Setup games on via face book, or webcast
19. SLA to approve all teams approved by their MA and roster.
20. SLA to provide schedule for the event working in cooperation with the host MA/AMA.
21. Programs to be made by the SLA, both the MA/AMA and SLA to work together for content and deadlines for entries.
22. To sell SLA clothing and other products
23. To provide an online sales tool on the website



HOST RESPONSIBILITIES

1. booking arenas
 - Min amount of 3 arenas from Wednesday to Sunday 8 am to 11 pm
2. Blocking rooms at least 300
3. Setting up of campgrounds for RV and Trailer
4. Provide Hotel Options to SLA for booking at minimum of 24 rooms for Convenors, RIC, Officials, Staff, and Board Members
5. Plan fundraising layout and send to SLA.
6. Plan for an opening ceremony send to SLA 15 minutes after games on Friday.
7. Provide transportation for officials, RIC's, and convenors.
8. Possible shuttle service between the event building
9. Look for local grants.
10. Look for local sponsors.
11. Internet Wi-Fi for facilities must be able to handle live streaming (Whenever possible)
12. Friday night smoker or some event
13. To bring their full event plan 2 years prior to the event at the box sector meeting
14. Provide information to the SLA and box sector on all planning meetings and events.
15. To provide a room for the coaches meeting this will be organized with the SLA office.
16. To provide a room for the officials meeting this will be organized with the SLA office.
17. To provide a room for the whole event for the SLA convenors and other meetings
18. To provide a photographer and videographer in coordination with the SLA

HOST REQUIREMENTS

1. MA will host if they are not able to host, they will be allowed to trade but must have the agreement done prior to sector meetings 2 years prior to them hosting.
2. If MA wishes to combine with another MA to meet hosting qualifications, they can but an agreement must be in place 2 years prior to the sector meetings.
3. If a MA decides to not host the box sector will accept applications for the open event, the event will have priority to the north south rotation. (so, if the was supposed be host by south team priority will go to south over north bid)
4. The SLA will reserve the right to remove hosting rights from any club that cannot meet the minimum requirements.
5. Must attend the last two provincials prior to applying for the event and cannot host with less than 4 years prior to open date.

SCHEDULE AND TIMES OF PLAY

1. First weekend of July
2. The SLA box sector to provide the schedule.
3. 2 teams best of 3
4. 3 teams round robin 2 plays 3 for Bronze winner plays 1st for gold.
5. 4 teams round robin 1st place vs 2nd place for gold and silver 3rd place vs 4th place for bronze
6. 5 teams round robin 1st place vs 2nd place for gold and silver 4th place vs 5th place winner plays 3rd place for bronze.
7. 6 teams two pools of 3 round robin both pools then cross over 1st place A vs 2nd place B + 1st place B vs 2nd place A winners play for gold and silver losers play for bronze 3rd place A vs 3rd place B to play 2 games with a 10-minute mini game if needed.
8. 7 teams two pools one of 4 and one of 3 round robin both pools then cross over 1st place A vs 2nd place B + 1st place B vs 2nd place A winners play for gold and silver losers play for bronze 4th place plays 3rd place in other pool winner to play 3rd in pool with 4 teams.
9. This needs to go to 12 teams per division.



TEAMS PLACEMENTS

1. Box Sector chair, minor director, and 3 other members will be put together to rank teams.
2. Teams to be evaluated on season and tournament play.
3. Teams may not be place in the same division that they play in regular season.
4. (all leagues have rep at ranking meeting)

TEAM APPLICATIONS

1. Teams to apply on their own on system provided by the SLA.
2. Team application will be May 20th.
3. No Refunds of application after May 20th
4. MA's will approve applications of their teams.
5. MA's will be responsible to divide up players that do not have a team to attend.
6. No team shall pick up or ap more than 2 players to attend the championship.
7. Rosters must be filled in online with the application.
