## **Provincial Coach Certification Program**

- 1. To educate Athletes, Coaches, Instructors and parents regarding Kyorugi rules
- 2. To develop provincial coaches to fairly and accurately conduct Taekwondo games according to the competition rules set out by World Taekwondo
- 3. Provincial Certification will prepare Saskatchewan Students/Instructors to coach Provincial tournaments and get the maximum benefit to improve coaching skills
- 4. Effective January 1, 2026, this coach seminar is the minimum requirement to coach Sask WT sanctioned Taekwondo tournaments.
- 5. All students must have successfully completed "Respect In Sport" (RIS) training to take this seminar
- 6. This Coach Certification program is mandatory for those planning to take Taekwondo-Canada Assistant Instructor (AI) and Dojang Coach (DC) seminar(s)
- 7. All Dojang students and Instructors must be in good standing order with their Provincial/Territorial and Taekwondo Canada organization

### **Provincial Coach:**

- Purpose: concentrates on developing coaches as it applies to Kyorugi rules
- Minimum requirement: 14 years of age and Red Belt
- Focus: to get an understanding of the points, penalties, penalty hand signals, superiority, match decisions, knock down, video review (IVR) requests, sanctions, coaches conduct and dress code
- Seminar: Approximately 5-hour seminar that includes written and practical test
