

Gibsons and Area Recreation Centre 700 Park Road Gibsons, British Columbia - Visiting Team Protocol 2021-2022

Gibsons and Area Community Centre allows for entry of spectators up to a maximum of 290 people in the upper viewing area. All spectators must enter through the upper main entrance to the building. SCRD Arena staff will monitor capacity and confirm proof of vaccination for everyone 12 years and older prior to allowing entry. Adult spectators must carry picture ID as well. Spectators who do not provide proof will not be permitted access in keeping with the PHO. Those who are unable to adhere to facility rules will not be permitted to be in the arena. There is no "interior" access between the lower rink area and the viewing area.

Players and team personnel will enter at the lower entrance. A home team ambassador will be stationed at this entrance to allow for player and team personnel. All team personal must hold and prepare to present a valid BC Vaccination Passport as well as ID in keeping with the PHO. No verified passport, no entry. Team Personnel includes, Coaches, Safety & Manager. Safety and Manager can watch from spectator viewing once game is in session, they just need to leave and enter through the main entrance of the facility.

Sunshine Coast Arena - Visiting Team Protocol 2021-2022 SCA 5982 Shoal Way Sechelt, British Columbia

Sunshine Coast Arena allows for entry of spectators up to a maximum of 230 people in the rink viewing area. All spectators must enter through the main entrance to the building. SCRD Arena staff will monitor capacity and confirm proof of vaccination for everyone 12 years and older prior to allowing entry. Adult spectators should carry picture ID as well. Spectators who do not provide proof will not be permitted access in keeping with the PHO. Those who are unable to adhere to facility rules will not be permitted to be in the arena.

Players and team personnel will enter at a side entrance which will be propped open. A home team ambassador will be stationed at this entrance to allow for player and team personnel. As per the PHO Team personal must all have valid two dose vaccine passport for entrance. Team Personnel includes, Coaches, Safety & Manager. Safety and Manager can watch from spectator viewing once game is in session, they just need to leave and enter through main entrance.
