

Game Cancellation Policy

We wanted to make our membership aware of Soccer PEI's cancellation policy for U11 to U18 games.

In short, games can only be cancelled for weather (by the referee) or exceptional circumstances.

If a team cannot play due to low numbers, they will be assessed a forfeit loss and **\$400 fine**. If the cancellation occurs within 48 hours, the cost of the referees will also need to be paid.

As a not-for-profit organization, SPRSC is unable to cover this fine, so it is club policy that it is up to the parents of the team that forfeited to pay.

If your player is not able to make a game, please tell your coach or manager as far in advance as possible so they can arrange an adequate number of call ups. If your player misses a game with late or no notification to your coach/manager, please be mindful that numbers may already be low, and it could cause the team to incur a \$400 fine plus referee fees.
