



WHAT HAPPENS IF I'M RELEASED? 2019-2020

AMHL Major Midget AAA (MALE)

- All eligible 15-year-old players will move into the **AMMHL Minor Midget AAA** camp.
- All eligible Resident 16- and 17-year-old players will be assigned to the **NAMHL Major Midget AA** camp.
- All other releases must return to their Local Minor Hockey Association.

If you wish to Tryout for another Male Major Midget AAA team see Options below.

As part of the Elite (AAA) player movement process (see link below) you are permitted three (3) AAA tryout opportunities.

PLEASE NOTE NEW ADENDUM FOR MIDGET AAA PLAYER MOVEMENT for 2019 Below:

***** ADM Change for Midget AAA cuts:** There are changes with respect to the Alberta Development hockey model. There will be no movement of players who are cut unless they have been registered on HCR (Hockey Canada Registry). This effectively means that all the early cuts are trying out for Midget AA as they cannot go anywhere. This will facilitate creation of our AA teams much quicker. Please note that if a 15-year-old is cut from Major Midget, he can then try out for the AMMHL (15 AAA). If he is cut at that point, then as a 15-year-old, he still has the right to travel to the next closest zone to try out for another 15 AAA team as before.

If you wish to tryout for another Female Bantam Elite team, contact Hockey Alberta who will direct you the appropriate team based on the following criteria (but not limited to):

- a. Selection of teams which have identified a need for additional players
- b. Elimination of teams that are no longer accepting import players
- c. Team with greatest requirement to fill their roster
- d. Distance of travel for practice and games

Female Bantam and Midget Elite Player Movement Protocol

1. Player must tryout for the designated Elite team in their resident elite draw zone.
2. If released from that team the player must contact the designated league official for direction of team placement if they wish to have a second tryout within the Elite League. (See Criteria for Player Placement)
3. Should the player not make the team as designated by the league official, they return to their home LMHA.
4. Bantam aged players may only accelerate to Midget and tryout with a MAAA team or their designated Elite Draw Zone team. PeeWee age players may only accelerate to Bantam and tryout with their designated Elite Draw Zone team. Further player movement will not be allowed. Acceptance of this registration and acceleration is at the discretion of the association and is subject to their approval.
5. With each movement a Notification to Try Out form from the player's resident LMHA and a Waiver form from the previous team tryout must accompany the player to the next move prior to acceptance on behalf of the receiving team they are trying out for.

The League is not responsible for the appropriate paperwork for tryout purposes.

Criteria for Player Placement

Criteria for player placement outside of their elite draw zone shall include but not limited to:

- a. Selection of teams which have identified a need for additional players
- b. Elimination of teams that are no longer accepting import players
- c. Team with greatest requirement to fill their roster
- d. Distance of travel for practice and games

Roster Sizes and Cut-off Dates

"Tryout Roster" must be registered prior to first exhibition game up to maximum of 25 players

The registered roster must be declared in HCR to 15 players prior to first game (Regular Registration Status).


Team may carry additional 10 players as designated "Tryout Status" until September 30th.
