Jon Marrese Stickers

On November 16, 2023 the lacrosse community lost one of its own when Jon Marrese passed away from a lengthy and courageous battle with cancer.

The Titans have decided, along with the Rams and Miners, to honour Jonny who was a major influence on lacrosse in Edmonton. Jon grew up playing for the Rams where he then transitioned into playing for the Edmonton Miners Jr.B program. Jon then became an originating member of the Edmonton Miners Jr.A team that is still competing for the Minto Cup today. He grew to be one of the best junior lacrosse players in Canada and from that was drafted to be a member of one of the first Edmonton Rush teams where he competed in the National Lacrosse League. He went on to have a very successful local senior lacrosse career with the Sherwood Park Outlaws, Spruce Grove Slash, and Edmonton Miners. Jon often competed for and eventually won a Presidents Cup championship with the Sherwood Park Outlaws in 2007. Jon was a teammate of countless former Titans alumni including myself, Brian Broks, Blair Manning, Jordan Houtstra, Jesse Draper, Brandon and Steve Zwack. His connections to our club continue to remain deep.

Jon's brother Dave was also a prominent player for the Miners Jr and Sr teams and his dad has been an official for the GELC for around 25 years. He also left behind his wife Jamey, son Marek, daughter Afton and his mother Barb. We wear these stickers to tell his family that we stand behind them and I'm sure it will mean a lot to them each time they see one. Marek is U11, and Afton plays U9 for the Rams so we will expect to see their family around the rink a lot this season. My U9 team was lucky enough to play against Aftons team last weekend with Ron Maresse as our referee. It was our first game wearing our stickers on our helmets and the family was very moved to have the Titans support through this small but meaningful gesture.

Lacrosse is a very small community and I ask you all to join us in a tribute to a pillar of our lacrosse community gone to soon. He left behind countless friends, teammates, fans and a family we can send our love to by wearing these stickers. I want to thank the Titans executive for their unquestioned support on this. We will hand the stickers out to division directors, and they will pass them out to their teams very shortly.
