Women's Division Update

U11 Women - We will be transferring a minimum of 9 players from other clubs in the GELC to form two Titans teams. These transfers will NOT be finalized until the GELC meeting on March 20th. We will hold a dropin **March 18 @ 3:30 - 4:30 pm** (Millennium Place) or all U11 Titan players to work on skills - THIS WILL NOT BE YOUR U11 TEAM.

U13 Women - As we are only having one team at this division - we will hold a team practice **March 18 @ 4:30 - 5:30 pm** (Millennium Place)).

U15 Women - We are working on finding floor times that will work around ringette for this group. That said, we will be holding one drop-in **March 18 @ 5:30 - 6:30 pm** (Millennium Place) for all U15 Titan players to work on skills - THIS WILL NOT BE U15 TEAM.

U17 Women - From a league perspective, we are excited that there are expected to be four well rostered (18) players/team in the U17 league for GELC. We will not have 2 Titans teams at this level, so currently we are waiting on the other clubs to confirm player transfers and are working to build these teams to create good competition. We will be reaching out to the waitlisted players with information for the potential of these players to all be together in another club. We will have a practice time very soon.
