GELC Winter League 2020

Have you heard the exciting news for box lacrosse for this fall? GELC is hosting a winter 4x4 league for box lacrosse for the first time! It will run from Oct-Jan. Team registration deadline October 5, 2020. Player registration deadline will be the October 18, 2020. Contact the GELC directly if you want to join a team at 780-466-0981.

<u>**Criteria:**</u> Any Competitive Introduction in Training Coach may submit a team to play in any division of the GELC winter league. Only one additional coach may be included in the team. This coach must have appropriate level coaching for the division coaching at.

Season: Teams will play four on four lacrosse in accordance with the ALA regulations. Regulation 16

- Teams will consist of 10 players, 2 coaches
- 4 teams, and 2 officials will make up the cohort group that will compete in the following divisions.
- Teams will participate in 24 games, played two games per session once per week. One additional final game for top two teams in the cohort group will be played.
- ALA regulation 16.01.4 (The duration of the game shall be two 10-minute run time periods with a 1-minute intermission between a face-off. The clock shall only stop for an injury.
- Games will be played in Beaumont, potentially Leduc Spruce Grove and St. Albert.

<u>Players</u>: Individual players expressing interest will be placed on a list for the appropriate division and the GELC will create a team where enough players are registered, or the names and contact information of coaches looking for players in a specific division will be provided to the families looking for a team to participate on.

<u>Age Divisions</u>: Maximum 4 teams per age group and division on a first come basis. Once a division is full any additional teams will be placed on a waiting list until an additional cohort group can be formed.
