Evaluations

We are in the process of building our schedule for warmup skates (not mandatory). What we do know is our first skate will be August 13th and last one is scheduled August 27th. There are ice times for all divisions during these dates so there will be plenty of opportunity for our athletes to knock the summer rust off.

New this year as directed by Ringette Alberta all athletes in U10, 12 and 14 must have **scheduled** skate before UAA's (exception is AA tryouts). Those skates will take place the week of August 29, 2022 more details to come from your division director.

Power AA try outs will begin August 28, 2022. AA registration closes **August 15, 2022**

For U12 and 14 athletes like previous years UAA's will take place on September long weekend Sept 4, 2022. UAA's for U10's will be determined at later date.

Further communications will be done through your division directors closer to evaluation process.
