Knock the Rust off Skates are optional and will provide an opportunity for players to get back on their skates and prepare for upcoming UAA's and game play evaluations. Registration is still open for our last skate via your RAMP account. \$20/skate

Evaluation Dates

Evaluation dates are tentative and subject to change. You will receive an email with your athletes' time slot closer to the evaluation date.

You will be assigned a time slot for a UAA Pre-Skate. These are not mandatory or included in evaluations but are highly encouraged. Please let me know if you are not going to be attending your assigned Pre-Skate so I can ensure there are balanced numbers in both groups.

Evaluations will consist of UAA Timed Evaluations completed by Competitive Thread as well as two game play evaluations. Groups will be organized and sent out prior to UAA's. Groups will be shifted and reevaluated after the UAA and again after the first game play evaluation, please keep an eye on your emails during this time to ensure your player is attending the correct skate time.

Goalies will participate in an individual skill evaluation and will also be assigned to a gameplay evaluation.

^{**}If your athlete is not able to attend any of the skates, please contact me. If your child doesn't show up without us knowing, it will reflect negatively in their evaluation.

During evaluations, communication will be provided as quickly as possible, but this will likely be late at night and at short notice for the next skate. Please be diligent in checking emails.

Once the evaluation process has completed, the team selection committee will meet. Teams will be announced via email and practices will be set to start ASAP.

Volunteers

Parent volunteers will be required during the evaluation skates to run benches, penalty doors, timeclock, shot clock and sign-in desk. I will send out sign up links as we approach the ice times. Please sign up to help where and when you can. *Parents cannot volunteer to be on the same bench as their athlete.*

Communication

In addition to the emails you receive from your Division Directors, SPRA sends out important information throughout the season. We have had parents reach out who are not receiving these emails. This is either due to emails being in their junk folders (please check regularly) or because they unsubscribed from RAMP emails through another sport. As RAMP is connected across all sports, you need to contact RAMP directly to have your email reinstated.
