Specific evaluation dates for goaltenders will be communicated to those who have expressed interest in playing in that position this year. Unless otherwise communicated, please attend your assigned evaluation group. New to the Board this year is our Goaltender Development Director. (goaliedevelopment@sherwoodparkringette.ca) We are always looking to recruit more goaltenders! If you or someone you know would like to try, please reach out.

The number of teams and team size will be determined by finalized registration numbers and availability of goalies. (we will try hard to have at least one goalie per team, but this may not be possible) The levels at which our teams compete will be determined by the Ringette Alberta Tiering Policy as in previous years.

Coaching staff for each team (other than AA) will be selected once teams are created and will consider, among other things, the Ringette Alberta requirement of at least one certified female coach on each team.

If your child is interested in declaring his/her intention to play at the B level, this must be received in writing (to: u19director@sherwoodparkringette.ca) prior to the start of Evaluation Skate 3. Those wishing to declare B must still attend all evaluation skates.

I will (as always) be looking for volunteers to make sure things run smoothly for all ice times. Please watch your email for opportunities to help. These evaluations cannot run without the help of volunteers. Volunteer jobs will include: bench help (you cannot go on the same bench as your athlete), time keeper, shot clock operator, penalty box, and check in/out table.

To help inform our evaluation process, I will be sending out a google form to ask for your athlete's primary and secondary preferred positions. Watch your email for more information.

After evaluations are complete and teams created, you will get an email indicating which team your athlete is on. As per Sherwood Park Ringette Association Guidelines and Procedures Manual 11.1, player evaluation and placement is not subject to the right to appeal.

The regular season start date will be determined by BGL.
