Player Placement Decisions:

- All Assessments handed to SPDSA Staff/Technical Leads after each session is completed.
- Assessments are scored & compiled based upon the above criteria in addition to any in season assessments
- SPDSA Staff and Tech Leads will facilitate discussion and players will begin to be identified and placed.
- Final decisions on player selection and placement are made by the age appropriate Technical Lead, SPDSA Technical Staff, and SPDSA Head Coaches.

• Players will continue to attend tryouts as they progress unless otherwise communicated.

• Upon completion of the process, selected or placed players are contacted by the team coaches. At that time the coach may explain the seasonal plan and the commitment level required. Follow up from the Technical Lead will occur prior to pre-season sessions.

• Players not placed on a Tier 1 or Tier 2 team will be advised via email to attend Tier 3 assessments.

• Players not placed on a Tier 3 team will receive an e-mail stating that the player has been placed in the SPDSA Community program. If the player does not wish to play in the community program an e-mail needs to be sent to the SPDSA indicating such.
