



Shuswap Minor Lacrosse and the Shuswap Showdown Tournament Committee strive to support good sportsmanship and fair play, while remaining a competitive and fun tournament.

All participants are required to adhere to this Code of Conduct for the tournament and for the purposes of this document when referencing participants, it will include all players, bench staff, team staff, parents, family members, and spectators or any person attending the tournament.

1. Participants acknowledge the tournament rules that were distributed separately from this document, key points including:
 - a. Discipline for the tournament will be enforced by the Tournament Commissioner in accordance with the BCLA 2026 Discipline Guideline
 - b. Team officials (i.e. coaches and managers) are responsible for the conduct of their players and parents on tournament property
 - c. The tournament committee reserves the right to remove from the tournament any player, coach, or spectator that behaves in a manner considered inappropriate for a minor sporting event

2. Participants are to treat everyone with respect and dignity - there will be zero tolerance to any acts of harassment or abuse towards referees, tournament volunteers, or participants of the tournament - this includes inappropriate posts on social media platforms

3. Participants are to respect the facilities in which the games are played, including
 - a. Staying in the lobby and spectator areas of the arena and only entering the changeroom hallway as needed for games
 - b. No balls are to be thrown on facility property (outside of games being played in the arenas) – this includes wall ball against arena wall, playing pass, etc
 - c. Teams are not to leave any items (equipment, waste, etc) in dressing rooms after their game and are expected to leave the dressing rooms tidy and ready for the next group
