As a coach of a Smoky Lake Minor Hockey Association (SLMHA) team(s), you have the responsibility to:

- 1) Acknowledge winning is a consideration, but not the only one, nor the most important one. You should care more about the child than winning the game.
- 2) Be a positive role model to your players, display emotional maturity and be alert to the physical safety of players.
- 3) Be generous with your praise when it is deserved; be consistent; be honest; be fair and just; do not criticize players publicly; learn to be a more effective communicator and coach; do not yell at players.
- 4) Adjust to the personal needs and problems of players, be a good listener, never verbally or physically abuse a player or official; give all players the opportunity to improve their skills, gain confidence and develop self-esteem; teach them the basics.
- 5) Organize practices that are fun and challenging for your players. Familiarize yourself with the rules, techniques, and strategies of hockey; encourage all your players to be team players.
- 6) Maintain an open line of communication with your players' parents. Explain the goals and objectives of your association.
- 7) Be concerned with the overall development of your players. Stress good health habits and clean living.
- 8) Ensure the locker room and bench are safe places for the players.
- 9) To play the game is great; to love the game is better.

#### **Coach Contract**

- 1) I will be reasonable when scheduling games and practices, remembering that players have other interests and obligations.
- 2) I will teach my players to play fairly and to respect the rules, officials, and opponents.
