**2.02 - Fees plus late fees –** Conundrum due to the dates in the 2025 HB teams in the A, B & D divisions must register for the Provincial before the team registration deadline. The Provincial date is July 11, but the registration for women's teams has a deadline of June 15. Recommend that A, B and D teams register early like June 8 to ensure the team is registered before committing to the provincial. Intermediate A and C teams are not affected by the overlapping dates. Their deadline is June 25. Remember late team or provincial registrations are subject to \$100 fines.

**2.03 - Cost for Men's and Women's Provincial is confirmed to be.** \$600 plus GST per team (for 2025)..

**2.04 - All Star Team Update and Coach Selection – Update –** Posting to be up in a day or two. Coach to be selected by May 2 target date. From the committee Deb Tidy was willing to coach the team and Barry Riva agreed to provide the credentials for the coach requirement. Nationals are in Saskatoon, SA from July 30 – August 3, 2025. Both understand the coach providing their own transportation, meals and accommodation fees. Laura to get the posting up asap. Barry and Deb will apply. Mindy added that players were eager to attend tryouts and be selected. Al had mentioned a deposit once players were selected. LOI needs to be done by June 1 and the \$850 participation fee raised.
