Subject: Minor Softball Rules, Volunteer Umpires, U11C Celebration,

U11R Showcase, and U13C Regional Events

Softball BC Members,

As the 2025 season approaches, please find updated information regarding the U9C, U11C, U11R, and U13C categories.

Updates to the Minor Softball Rules for U9C, U11C, U11R, and U13C

Softball Canada has developed a systematic plan to guide players from the moment they enter the sport until they reach their full potential. This process, known as Long-Term Player Development (LTPD), provides essential guidelines to align player and program development across the country and within our province at all levels and ages. Softball BC's minor softball rules are based on the LTPD model and the Athlete Development Matrix established by Softball Canada.

This year, the U11R classification has been added to the Minor Softball Rules. Additionally, updates have been made to the U9C, U11C, and U13C categories. Softball BC will implement these Minor Softball Rules for Celebration, Showcase, and Regional events.

These rules are included in the <u>2025 Handbook</u>, which will be available online on March 21. Hard copies will be shipped out the week of March 31. Feel free to contact your <u>District Minor Coordinator</u> for questions.

Volunteer Umpire - U11C and under only

We want to take a moment to address a critical issue affecting our sport—the shortage of umpires. Many associations are struggling to find enough officials to cover games across all age categories.

For U11C and below, if a certified umpire is unavailable, the game may proceed with a **volunteer umpire**, provided they wear full protective gear, including shin guards, a chest protector, and an umpire mask with a throat protector (or a catcher's mask). An infielder face



mask or a helmet with a cage **do not** meet the required safety standards. The volunteer umpire must position themselves behind the plate to call pitches and cannot call balls and strikes from anywhere else on the field. The volunteer umpire must be 16 years of age or older. If no volunteer is available, the game will be cancelled.

For U11 Rep and above categories and classifications, if a certified umpire is unavailable, the game will be cancelled.
