

JOHN BLUMBERG SOFTBALL COMPLEX PARK POLICIES



The Manitoba Softball Association (MSA) will maintain agreements with The City of Winnipeg for John Blumberg Softball Complex (JBSC).

1. OUTSIDE ALCOHOL

- The JBSC does not allow any outside alcohol into the park. As JBSC is a Manitoba Liquor & Lotteries licensed facility, the management reserves the right to search equipment bags, coolers, etc. **AT ANY TIME**.
- Alcoholic beverages must be purchased and consumed in designated areas only. Under no circumstances will alcoholic beverages be allowed on the playing field.
- Anyone caught bringing alcohol into JBSC will have any and all alcohol confiscated.
- Any person/league caught with outside alcohol is subject to the following fines:
 - 1st Offence: \$100.00 fine to the league***
 - 2nd Offence: \$150.00 fine to the league***
 - > 3rd Offence: The offending team will be suspended from all games at Blumberg

In all matters, a FINE and/or SUSPENSION Letter will be sent to the League.

2. <u>PETS</u>

There are no pets of any kind allowed into or on the grounds of JBSC. Patrons with pets will be asked to remove said pet(s) from the park. Service animals are allowed in the park and if possible, should be clearly identified with Service Animal Identification Tag and/or a Service Animal Vest with Embroidered Service Animal Patch. Should the service animal have no easily identifiable tags/vest, then upon request, a certificate of verification must be produced.

3. TEAM/PLAYER BEHAVIOUR

All league presidents, coaches and/or managers are responsible for the conduct of their players and must ensure that all players are aware of our rules and regulations. Individuals that contravene any rules of the complex jeopardize further participation of both themselves and their team at the John Blumberg Softball Complex.

4. **DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY**

Should any damages be caused by a spectator, official, player, coach or team, the party/parties involved will be required to pay for damages and will be suspended indefinitely from the park.

5. UMPIRES

Registered MSA and SPN officials will be allowed to officiate games at the John Blumberg Softball Complex. SPN officials will officiate only SPN sanctioned leagues and tournaments.

6. PARKING LOT

No tail-gate parties are permitted in the parking lot. The parking lot is patrolled by the RCMP and City of Winnipeg Police Service. All Municipal and City of Winnipeg by-laws will apply.

7. USAGE POLICIES

- No league will be allocated more than 25% of the time slots for league play, unless all leagues are satisfied and there are still slots remaining to be allocated. All leagues must submit a \$200 performance bond payable to the John Blumberg Softball Complex. For every default, a fee of \$60.00 will be deducted from the Leagues Performance Bond. The performance bond must be replenished in full by the end of the current softball year to be in good standing for the following year. If games are cancelled within 48 hours the game will not be considered a defaulted game. Notice must be sent by email to the Facility Manager to the following email address: montejbsc@gmail.com
- Gate reimbursement will not be the responsibility of the John Blumberg Softball Complex in the event of a defaulted or forfeited game. This will be considered a league issue. NO rain checks will be issued in case of inclement weather during the games. Slot fees are **NOT** refundable due to rainouts. It will be the leagues responsibility for inquiring about slots and dates to make up games that are lost due to inclement weather.

8. CANNABIS IN MANITOBA

Softball Manitoba and the John Blumberg Softball Complex will adhere to the Liquor, Gaming & Cannabis Act of Manitoba. Smoke and Vape Cannabis will not be allowed. Any person caught smoking or vaping Cannabis will be ask to leave the park immediately. If person is on the bench and is caught smoking or vaping Cannabis and refuses to leave, the game that is being played will be forfeited.

9. PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

John Blumberg Softball Complex strongly recommends that ADULT LEAGUE pitchers wear facemask while playing league games.
