Requirements for coaching staff (Head Coach, Assistant Coaches, Managers) at the AA level:

- All coaching staff must have a valid **Respect in Sport** Certificate within the last five (5) years to be eligible to register with Softball Manitoba. Information to complete this 3-hour on-line course can be found here, <https://www.softball.mb.ca/content/respect-in-sport>
- All coaching staff must have a valid **Criminal Record Check** within the last five (5) years to be eligible to register with Softball Manitoba. Full requirements and links to complete a CRC can be found here, <https://www.softball.mb.ca/content/criminal-record-checks>
- All coaching staff must have completed **NCCP Creating a Positive Sport Environment**
 - **How to register and complete NCCP Creating a Positive Sport Environment**
 - Log into your Locker Profile here, <https://thelocker.coach.ca/account/login?mode=login>
 - Click “Forgot password” on the login page to retrieve this information if you have forgotten.
 - Once you are logged into the Locker, your NCCP dashboard will appear. Select the **ELEARNING** tab at the top of the page. The default is showing “Multi-Sport”. Under the “Available” menu scroll down until you see, **NCCP Creating a Positive Sport Environment**.
 - Click on **NCCP Creating a Positive Sport Environment**. Read the instructions and when you are ready click the **PAY NOW** button at the bottom to start the course.

How to register and complete Foundations of Coaching Softball: Part 1

- Log into your Locker Profile here, <https://thelocker.coach.ca/account/login?mode=login>
 - If you have forgotten your login credentials, click “Forgot password” on the login page to retrieve your information.

- Once you are logged into the Locker, your NCCP dashboard will appear. Select the **ELEARNING** tab at the top of the page. Then scroll down the page and select “Softball” (the default is showing “Multi-Sport”). Under the “Available” menu you will see all the Softball e-Learning modules available to complete.
- Click on **Foundations of Coaching Softball – Part 1**. Read the instructions and when you are ready click the **PAY NOW** button at the bottom to start the course.

How to register and complete Make Ethical Decisions (February until March 31, 2026, 11:59:59 PT)

- Log into your Locker Profile here, <https://thelocker.coach.ca/account/login?mode=login>
 - If you have forgotten your login credentials, click “*Forgot password*” on the login page to retrieve your information.
- Once you are logged into the Locker, your NCCP dashboard will appear. Select the **CALENDAR** tab at the top of the page.
- You can set the filter to whatever preference you want (month, year, province). Once you find a **Make Ethical Decisions** course on the calendar on a date that works for you, click on it. It will then appear on the right-hand side of the page. Click on that link and it will bring you to a dedicated page to register.
- If the dedicated page indicates that the clinic is full you will have to look for another date.

How to register and complete NCCP Make Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation (February until March 31, 2026, 11:59:59 PT)

- Log into your Locker Profile here, <https://thelocker.coach.ca/account/login?mode=login>
 - If you have forgotten your login credentials, click “*Forgot password*” on the login page to retrieve your information.
- Once you are logged into the Locker, your NCCP dashboard will appear. Select the **ELEARNING** tab at the top of the page. The default is showing “Multi-Sport”. Under the “Available” menu scroll down until you see, **NCCP Make Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation**.

How to register and complete Make Ethical Decisions (as of April 1, 2026)

- Coaches will be required to access **NCCP Make Ethical Decisions** through **The Locker** at <https://thelocker.coach.ca/account/login?mode=login>
- The new eLearning module will feature both the training and evaluation.
- The instructions **above** will be replaced with new login details on April 1, 2026.
