# **Regional Skills Development Academy FAQs**

# Why are the pitcher/catcher sessions more expensive?

This is because there will be a pitching and catching session, a defensive session as well as an offensive session. Position players will only have a defensive and offensive session.

# Can we come both days?

No. Athletes are to sign up for the position that reflects their strength. Example. If you are an average pitcher, but an outstanding 2ndbase athlete – then it may be wise to select the position player training and not the pitching slot. If you are a strong pitcher as well as a great 2ndbase athlete then you should probably sign up for the pitcher slot.

# What if I am strong at pitching or catching as well as another position (infield/outfield)? Will I receive training for infield/outfield in the Friday slots?

Yes! That is why the pitchers/catchers pay a little bit more and have to commit more time. There is a defensive segment to their session in addition to the pitching and catching training.

# What age category will I be in?

U14 – 2007/2008 birth years U16 – 2005/2006 birth years U18 – 2003/2004 birth years

# How does payment work?

Payment (cheques) can be mailed or dropped off at Softball Manitoba. E- transfers are also accepted (<u>softball@softball.mb.ca</u>). If you would prefer to pay in installments, that can also be arranged with Kendall at Softball Manitoba. Payment not required until you are accepted into the academy.

# How does registration work?

The week of August 3<sup>rd</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> is registration week. **Registration is not first come first serve**. You can register at any point between August 3<sup>rd</sup>-7<sup>th</sup>. Athletes will be accepted and notified by August 14<sup>th</sup>. All "A" level athletes who are interested are encouraged to register. There are limited slots for pitchers and catchers and so we would encourage you to be open to a position player spot, should you not get in as a pitcher/catcher.
