RULES

U15 Boy's Eastern Canadians will follow the Softball Canada rule book guidelines, including:

- No time limit
- All innings are open
- Standard mercy rules in effect (15 after 3, 10 after 4, 7 after 5)
- International tie breaker rules for extra innings
- Bat 9 allowing for substitutions (DP/Flex)
- No pitching restrictions
- No playing time restrictions



Tie Breaking and Best Record

1. After round robin – positions will be determined by wins and losses.
2. If the teams are tied in wins and losses the positions will be declared as follows:
 - A. If 2 teams are tied in single round robin play whoever defeated the other will get the higher position. If double round robin play if one team defeated the other twice they will get the higher position. If they each defeated each other the 7 plus/minus rule would apply. (See C).
 - B. If 3 or 4 teams are tied for any position, teams with the best plus/minus record (see C) will be declared the highest to the lowest positions.
 - C. **The best Record: Is the difference plus/minus of total runs scored in each game to a maximum of seven runs plus/minus difference for each game played and totaled. In 3 ½, 4 ½, 5 ½, 6 ½, 8 ½ etc. innings back to 3,4,5,6,7, and 8 full innings etc.**
 - D. **Tie Breaking formula:**
 - 1) The first scenario in breaking the 3 or 4 team tied positions is the best record (7 plus/minus) between the tied team's games. This should rank them highest to lowest positions.
 - 2) If 2 teams are still tied whoever defeated the other will get the higher position.
 - 3) If 3 or more teams are still tied after scenario one, (if there 4 teams tied and one team had a difference of the other 3 that team will be higher or lower than the other 3 and would not figure in the further tie breaking scenarios), tied positions will be declared for the least number of runs scored, against between the tied team games.
 - 4) If teams are still tied the most runs scored in all games played between the tied team games will be used.
 - 5) If 3 or more teams are still tied scenarios 1,3 and 4 will be repeated as necessary with all games played.
 - 6) If 3 or more teams still tied after all scenarios flips of coin(s) will decide positions

To clarify positions for best record, if a team at bat wins the game in their bottom half of the inning, it will be deemed a full half inning even through there is less than three outs. If they win the game and do not have to play any part of their last half inning (bottom), the score will be, as far as plus or minus runs are concerned, to the end of the last bottom half of the previous inning. *Under no circumstances will a last at bat bottom half inning be started if the last at bat team is leading when the top half of the inning is completed and they have won the game.* Also, if the team last at bat wins the game on an over the fence home run, all the runs will count and runs plus/minus will be calculated as a game inning.
