c. U19 Women's


i. Two interviews conducted for the position of Head Coach. The hiring committee recommended Jeremy Tracy as Head Coach.

10. Umpires Update - Ron Campbell

a. 2022 Plans

i. Goal for 2022 is to reach 120 registered umpires







ii. Will be very busy. Anticipating needing 6 umpires for the U19 Canadian Championships in Fredericton, and there is a lot of interest for umpires to travel to other Championships across the country.

b. Proposed Budget

- i. 2022 umpire draft budget was presented
 - 1. Ron will refine budget over the next few months as the season approaches and Covid 19 restriction ease.

c. Blue Convention

- i. If the event goes, Ron is planning for 10 umpires to attend.
- ii. Umpires branch is supplying \$300 to NB umpires to attend to help offset some of their costs
- iii. Matt will be attending the event as a presenter
 - 1. Event was canceled Monday January 31st. 2022 and rescheduled for 2023.

11. Timbits - ANGELA

- a. Angela presented a <u>powerpoint presentation</u> on the 2021 season and her 2022 plans for Timbits Community Caravan
 - Angela is currently sending out postcards to community groups that had sessions in 2021 as a reminder of their session and a way of maintaining the relationship
 - ii. Expanding visits in 2022 / goal number of athletes to be reached (1000+)
 - iii. Maintaining visits in all 8 regions, and increasing presence in regions 1,2,7,8
 - iv. Implement a \$150 fee to unregistered communities/groups to offset program costs
 - v. Expanding on relationships with First Nations Communities

- Angela is recommending having 6 summer students in 2022, and 2-3 caravan crews running throughout the summer to increase capacity. Would like to have 2 students in Regions 3, 4, 5. This will reduce the number of evenings and long travel students have to endure throughout the summer

12. 2022 Proposals

- a. Canada Games Tune Up Tournament
 - This tournament will be held in Fredericton as a 'test run' of the Canadian
 Championships, and will also be a way of generating 'hype' for the tournament
 - ii. Tournament will be open to both Men's and Women's CSG programs, as well as the Atlantic U19/U23 Provincial Team Women's programs
- b. Middle School Provincials
 - i. Board reviewed the Middle School Provincials document and is in favor of proceeding with the tournament as presented
 - ii. \$150 registration fee (Approved January 2020)
 - 1. Registration fee due 2 weeks in advance
- c. Adult Slo Pitch

- 2. New to addition to 2022
 - a. A fully registered league will receive a discount on balls (1 dozen per registered team @ \$55). Additional balls can be purchased at regular price
 - b. Scott presented a slo pitch proposal of offering a tip off tournament (June/July)

 - Conversation from the board surrounding the approach of targeting the Western part of the province, and are instead recommended an entire province approach (i.e. various regions and communities. Ex. Miramichi, etc.)
 - 2. SNB will occur cost of hosting the tournament regardless of location
 - ii. Moving to a registration fee model rather than pay as you go (outlined in proposal)
 - 1. Plaques/Awards will be provided
 - 2. Umpires will be paid by SNB
