



## 2029 Canada Summer Games Application

Softball Nova Scotia is beginning the process to select coaches for both the female and male 2029 Canada Summer Games programs. The 2029 Games will be held in Moncton and the Saint John Region in New Brunswick.: Female team will be in week one the Male team will be in week two.

Call for Canada Games Coaches for both Male & Female

- Softball Nova Scotia requires the following three roles for coaching staff for each Men & Women Canada Games team:
- Head Coach
- Assistant Coach
- Team Manager
- **Male Team** will consist of two (2) Coaches and one (1) manager.
- **Female team** -At least one (1) of the coaches must be female (either head/or assistant coach)
- **Role of the Head Coach**
- The Head Coach must demonstrate advanced knowledge of the technical and tactical aspects of Softball.
- Must be Competition Development Certified.
- Must possess excellent leadership skills, and executes, and supervises all aspects of the Canada Games Team program. Previous Canada Games experience an asset.
- Team training, & development sessions including at-home and away Practices, Games, & tournaments.
- Must have experience in planning training Camps, travelling in a team environment, dealing with parents, structuring meetings, supervising coaches, evaluating athletes, ability to follow procedures etc.



- Must be a member in good standing with Softball Nova Scotia Sport Organization.

### **Role of Assistant Coach**

The role of the Assistant Coach is to assist the Head Coach in completing all tasks in the preparation for the athletes attending the 2029 Canada Summer Games.

Assistant Coach must be Competition Development Trained

The Assistant Coach must demonstrate an advanced knowledge of the technical aspects of Softball.

This includes planning, executing, participating in, and assist supervising all aspects of the Canada Games.

The Assistant Coach will assist with the team planning in collaboration with the head coach, executes, and supervises all aspects of the Canada Games Team program, and assists with team training, & development sessions including at-home and away Practices, Games, & Tournaments.

### **Role of The Team Manager**

The Manager is responsible for supervising, managing and motivating team members. As a team leader, the Manager will be the point of contact for all team members.

The manager must have excellent communication skills. The manager should also be able to act proactively to ensure smooth team operations and effective collaboration and handle aspects like team training, travel, and administration.

The manager will Spearhead public relations between athletes, coaches, other athletic personnel, and media in with Softball Nova Scotia policies.

Perform accounting for team travel plans, balancing and organizing team financial obligations. Scheduling public events where members of your team will be present and documented.

**All Applicants** will be subject to a screening process, including mandatory Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Check, in compliance with the Softball Nova Scotia Safe Sport Policy.



Head Coach, Assistant Coach and Manager must commit to a minimum three -year term preparation plan culminating with participation in the 2029 Canada Summer Games in Moncton and Saint John New Brunswick.

The Head Coach and coaching staff are subject to an evaluation by Softball Nova Scotia on an understanding that appointment to this position may be rescinded at any time during the term if all requirements of the Program are not fulfilled.

It will be the responsibility of the head coach to work within the Softball Nova Scotia policies and procedures, approved budget, and administrative process for all travel, equipment, and uniform purchases. Head Coach will be responsible for submitting bi-annual Canada Games program reports to Softball NS.

Athlete selection must follow Softball NS selection process guidelines. Athlete selection will be lead by the head coach and the coaching staff, in conjunction with a series of independent evaluators and the Softball Nova Scotia; identification camps will be held at key locations and scouting at key events will be required.

### **Certification Requirements**

Head Coach,) must have NCCP Competition Development Certified.

Assistant Coach Manager must achieve NCCP Competition Development trained Status.

Head Coach and Coaching staff are expected to uphold and support the rules of the Canada Summer Games and Softball Nova Scotia. Interview Process will take place at Sport Nova Scotia.
