



2022 RETURN TO PLAY SANCTION REQUEST FORM

Every Association/League in Saskatchewan that intends to resume softball activities in 2022 must receive sanction approval from Softball Saskatchewan. Softball activities are defined as any ID/evaluation camp, practice, skill development camp/clinic, game, meeting, coaching clinic or umpire clinic. Any Association/League that resumes softball activities without approval from Softball Sask will be considered an Association Not in Good Standing and will not be covered by Softball Sask Insurance until such time as the sanction approval has been received from Softball Sask.

Associations/Leagues can submit this form to Softball Sask to receive sanction to resume softball activities in 2022.

What does sanction mean? By requiring Associations/Leagues to obtain sanction approval, participants can be assured that their interests as members of Softball Sask are being looked after. To obtain a sanction, an Association/League must meet standards set forth by Softball Sask that will ensure that safety protocols for all participants are in place while they are participating in softball activities.
