

THE PLATE CONFERENCE

- 1. Introduce yourself and/or your partner(s) to the coaches.
- 2. Ask the coach for the line-up card is used to confirm players and subs and ensure it is signed. Have the coach recheck it and then give it back to you, it is now official.
- 3. Go over specific rules (might be age-related) and any issue with the diamond (i.e.: Open holes in fences) and let the coaches know the rules will be applied when it happens.
- 4. Advise the coach if they have a question regarding a call to please ask for time and when granted respectfully approach the umpire that made the call. If needed umpires will discuss and give the final decision.
- 5. Ask coaches if they have any questions. if not let's have a good game and let's play ball.
- 6. Thank the coaches.
