- 1. See SHMA Fundraising and Sponsorship Policy and Guidelines posted on the website for details. The Association's policy and guidelines are to assist our members in meeting the financial obligations through initiatives that provide monetary remuneration AND foster community spirit and Association comradery.
- 2. Notes on Team Fundraising Activities:
  - Team Fundraising Activities provide an opportunity for teams to raise funds to help offset team costs such as team-specific activities, travel costs, or tournament fees.
  - Each team is encouraged to conduct at least two (2) fundraising activities per season AND is required to obtain at least one (1) Association sponsorship (\$500 minimum value).
  - 10% of team funds raised are returned to the Association for the benefit of the association membership.
  - No lotteries or draws are permitted at the team level due to licensing requirements.
  - All fundraising activities must be documented with the Association BEFORE commencing.
  - In no event should any funds raised through Team Fundraising Activities be allocated to the benefit of a single player or a subset of players on the team.
  - Single-player funding is available through KidSport to assist families experiencing financial hardship and graduating high school students through the SMHA Scholarship Program (disbursed by the Association).
- 3. The portion of contributions raised as representatives of SMHA that are returned to the Association will be used to benefit the entire association membership, such as a reduction of annual registration fees, ice time, etc. Use of the funds is reported in the board meeting minutes and at the Annual General Meeting.
