Interested in registering for the season? Here are some answers to a few FAQs to get you started!

How do I register with SCRA?

• Go to <u>https://southcalgaryringette.com/</u> and click on "Registration" for all the details.

Who can register with SCRA?

- Our registration area primarily includes the SW quadrant of Calgary. Depending where you live, you may be in the boundaries of SCRA or the other associations in the city – BowView (NE/SE) or NW Ringette (NW/NE). Check the registration map on the Ringette Calgary website for the specific boundaries. https://ringettecalgary.ca/registration/
- We have divisions for youth aged 5-18 years old, from Active Start up to U19 age groups.
- Community Ringette is a co-ed sport. We welcome young athletes of all genders and orientations to join in the fun.

How much does it cost to register?

- Our fees are under the Registration section of the website on the "Fee Details" page.
- New this year we have reduced fees for our small-ice format divisions. (Active Start, U10 Step 1 and U10 Step 2)
- We also offer reduced fees for Full-Time and Part-Time goalies!

What do we need for equipment?

- See the "Equipment Guidelines" page under the "Parents and Players" section for full info.
- Ringette stick, helmet with Ringette cage, Ringette girdle, hockey skates, shin guards, elbow pads, shoulder pads, neck guard, gloves, Ringette pants, jersey.
- Ringette Store (online) and Play It Again Sports (Westhills).
- You can also find gear at the usual stores like Source for Sports, Sport Chek, etc.

What can we expect for the season?

- You can expect a lot of fun with great friends!
- Our season runs September to mid March.
- Our teams compete in the Chinook League which is coordinated by Ringette Calgary.
- Depending on the age group, players can expect 2 or more ice times per week. (ie. Active Start typically has 1 or 2 ice times per week, up to our oldest age groups who may see 3 to 4 ice times per week depending on game schedules or tournaments.)
- Practices and games are on a non-fixed schedule and operate at a variety of arena locations in the city.

SCRA Game Pants: All South Calgary Ringette participants from the U10 to U19 levels are required to wear South Calgary branded Stinger/MossPro pants for all league and tournament games. The pants are sold exclusively through The Ringette Store - **#104A**, **9705 Horton Road SW**

SCRA Game Jerseys: Each team will be assigned a SCRA game jersey set with home/away colours. (Exception: AS teams will receive only one jersey.) Game jerseys are NOT to be used for practices.
