



## Team Alberta U16 & Alberta Summer Games Selection Camp

### CONGRATULATIONS!

On behalf of Board of Directors of Football Alberta, it is my pleasure to inform you that you have been nominated to attend the **Team Alberta U16 & Alberta Summer Games Selection Camp**. This summer Football Alberta will be participating in Football Canada U16 Western the Challenge in Abbotsford, BC and the 2020 Alberta Summer Games in Lethbridge. Depending on your age and what age category you played in 2019, you may be eligible to participate in both or just one, see the age eligibility requirements.

### Age Eligibility

**Alberta Summer Games:** Any Bantam aged player during the 2019 season (no Grade 10's)

**Team Alberta U16:** Players born in 2005 or 2006, no exceptions. (Grade 10's are allowed)

### 2020 Alberta Summer Games

#### Team Format – 4 Regions – NEW for 2020

- **SOUTH** - Zone 1 creating one team with the same previous boundaries (link to map below).
- **CALGARY METRO** - Zone 2/3 creating 3 teams (minimum of 35 from Zone 2).
- **CENTRAL** - Zone 4 creating one team with the same previous boundaries (link to map below).
- **EDMONTON NORTH** - Zone 5/6/7/8 creating 3 teams (minimum of 24 per zone).

#### STEP 1 - Selection Camps

- EDMONTON NORTH will host one Selection Camp and select 3 equal Alberta Summer Games teams
  - April 3-5 at U of A Foote Field.
  - A draft will be held by the coaches on April 5<sup>th</sup> to select the 3 teams.
  - In addition, 35 players will be named to the Team Alberta U16 Top 100 Selection Camp.
- CALGARY METRO will host one Selection Camp and select 3 equal Alberta Summer Games teams.
  - April 17-19 in Calgary at McMahon Stadium.
  - A draft will be held by the coaches on April 19<sup>th</sup> to select the 3 teams.
  - In addition, 35 players will be named to the Team Alberta U16 Top 100 Selection Camp.
- SOUTH will hold Selection Camps in Medicine Hat and Lethbridge to select one team.
  - Saturday April 18 – Methanex Bowl – Medicine Hat.
  - Saturday April 25 – U of L stadium – Lethbridge.
  - Saturday May 9 - Final Selection Camp in Lethbridge.
  - In addition, 15 players will be named to the Team Alberta U16 Top 100 Selection Camp.
- CENTRAL will hold a Selection Camp to select one team.
  - May 1-3 in Red Deer at Great Chief Park.
  - In addition, 15 players will be named to the Team Alberta U16 Top 100 Selection Camp.

## STEP 2 – Install Weekend

- Each team will host an Install weekend June 12-14, 2020.
- 3 in Edmonton, 1 in Red Deer, 3 in Calgary and 1 in Lethbridge.
- Each team is permitted a max of 2 practices Friday, 3 practices Saturday and a Sunday Walk-Through.
- On Sunday June 14<sup>th</sup> four seeding games will be played in Edmonton/Calgary to determine the schedule for the Alberta Summer Games. The games will be the Quarter Finals of the Alberta Summer Games.
- Accommodations and food are included in the registration fee.

## STEP 3 – 2020 Alberta Summer Games

- Wednesday July 22 - Practice Day in your region.
- Thursday July 23 - Travel Day & Opening Ceremonies.
- Friday July 24 - Game Day 1 in Lethbridge/Raymond.
- Saturday July 25 Practice Day.
- Sunday July 26 - Game 2 in Lethbridge/Raymond and travel home.

## Alberta Summer Games Cost to Participate

- \$85 – Selection Camp (players are responsible for their own accommodations and food).
- \$0 – Install Weekend (players must be transported to the venue, accommodations and food provided).
- \$300 – Alberta Summer Games (all costs covered).

## Team Alberta U16

### STEP 1 – Selection Camps

- All players must attend the Selection Camp in their designated zone. Only 2005/2006 born players.
  - SOUTH - Zone 1
  - CALGARY METRO - Zone 2/3
  - CENTRAL - Zone 4
  - EDMONTON NORTH - Zone 5/6/7/8

### STEP 2 – Top 100 Selection Camp

- Top 100 U16 Selection Camp held May 29-31 – Site TBD.
- 5 Practices and a Scrimmage.
- Players will be on their own for transportation, accommodations and meals.

### STEP 3 – Football Canada U16 Western Challenge

- Team Alberta Mini Camp – July 9-11, 2020 – Site TBD.
- Football Canada U16 Western Challenge Abbotsford, B.C. – July 11-17, 2020.
- 10 practices and 2 games.
- Team Registration includes airfare to Abbotsford, accommodations, meals, apparel and all team expenses.

## Team Alberta U16 Cost to Participate

- \$50 – Top 100 Selection Camp (players are responsible for their own accommodations and food).
- \$1,600 – Football Canada Western Challenge (players responsible for transportation to departure City).
