4. ADOPTION OF MINUTES

5. FINANCIAL REPORT PRESENTED

Shauna Paisley-Cooper requested U19 team to borrow funds from SGRA for tournament costs early in season. Team funds will not be set up in time for application to be complete.

6. DIRECTOR AND COMMITTEE REPORTS

- a. Sebastian Fuhr, Co-Ordinator of Goalie Development wants to host clinic to generate interest and has contacted Keely Brown with 5 Count. Potential to roate location with Edmonton, Fort Saskatchewan and Spruce Grove. Costs/goalie: \$55 at host arena, \$75 at visiting arena. Keely Brown may be better option that Rush team.
- b. Alison Church, Equipment: plenty of U10 goalie pads, 2 sets for U12 and none for levels above U12. There are a few sticks for U10 & U12 divisions, none for divisions above U12. As per Sebastian, sticks usually last one year, so may need to be purchased. Board reminded Alison there is a one time credit (reimbursement) of \$200 for full-time goalies.

- d. Tara Bogusky presented options for apparel: Source For Sports vs. Creative Promotional Marketing Agency. Online store to open September 1, 2021. Tara Bogusky motioned to change apparel provider from St. Albert Source for Sports to Creative Promotional MArketing Agency. Robin Pedlar seconded.
