Representative to Black Gold League:

BGL MEETING SUMMARY

- > Pretty good year for league no weather reschedules second session, no grievances, 1 protest, 2 suspensions for excess penalty time (1 player, 1 coach), 2 forfeits.
- > Calgary and zone 2 are happy being part of the BGL at u19AA.
- > Spectator liaison has about 80-90% compliance on game sheets. When uploading game sheets, make sure the liaison names are visible in picture. Few concerns with parents this year so, seems to be beneficial. Ensure this continues throughout playdowns and playoffs.
- > Associations will be responsible for their own lanyards next year.

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- > RIC reported that NARRA will be returning the BGL retainer that they keep as operating money and WILL BILL EACH ASSOCIATION SEPARATELY DEPENDING ON THE NUMBER OF TEAMS USING NARRA (U14A and up in SGRA). The actual \$ amounts will be made known at the AGM. Bills will be due to NARRA by October. (could be several \$1000)
- > Feedback requests for new step 1 format will be sent out shortly by RAB but seems to be successful and expect continued rollout as predicted.
- > U12 championship game sheets and 50% of operating monies have been distributed to associations hosting the events. (SGRA hosting u12A Gold) There is a technical manual available online indicating what (minimums) needs to be done to host. Tournament committees should be underway. Banners and medals will be available from BGL Treasurer (me) closer to the event (likely third week in feb). This should be run like a Provincials.
- > u10 all dates and locations for windups have been released. Actual schedule will be released after the final day of play.
- > All u10 s1 & 2 team sizes should be sent to BGL treasurer so windup swag can be distributed. Associations responsibility to collect swag. Should be available approx third week in feb.
- > S3 has gold and silver medals already distributed to host associations. (SGRA is one)
- > Effective immediately, all game scores should be reported immediately after the conclusion of the games as RAB is working on playdown schedules and ranking is important.
- > BGL AGM date tentatively set for mar 9 but may change due to RAB AGM (dates not released yet)
