(A) RINGETTE FOR ALL (KRYSTIE VILLENEUVE) 15 MIN
Krystie presented information on Ringette For All program - ran out of Edmonton
Ringette this season (first season facilitating) - looking to expand next season.
Edmonton, Calgary, Ottawa have programs.
Krystie proposes to run Ringette For All program for 10 children - first come first served,
(5-18 years old) 7+/- week program (1 @ ½ ice slot/week) - consistency needed. Ice availability factor.
Need to have at TLC (accessibility for athletes) and consistent ice time.
Coach needed, assistant and junior coaches (20 people on the ice, 1:1 ratio).
Challenges with ice submission to BGL (150% required for league to schedule games)
Coaches would require Initiation in Sport certification

Grants possible to access funds for this program Sign up through RAMP Krystie to look into insurance coverage, clarity on programming, registration (Edmonton Ringette) Krystie left meeting.

Joline suggested player assistance program used towards ice fees for program. Benefit for jr coaches to volunteer and player alike Board to look at creating a Ringette For All Co-ordinator for 2023/2024 season (pilot project) - Aaron to talk to Krystie about taking on role
