

Junior Funding

(Updated Oct 27, 2023)

- Squash Alberta will consider funding for a Squash Alberta member playing in an age group Main Event at the Canadian National Junior Squash Championships who meets ALL OF the following eligibility criteria in the current season:
 - a) Is a Squash Alberta Member in good standing;
 - b) Primarily reside in Alberta; and
 - c) Plays in sanctioned Squash Alberta Events as follows:
 - i. Minimum of one (1) Junior Gold Event in Calgary;
 - ii. Minimum of one (1) Junior Gold Event in Edmonton;
 - iii. Alberta Junior Jesters; and
 - iv. Alberta Junior Closed Provincial Championships
- 2. Squash Alberta will grant funding to the top two (2) ranked eligible Squash Alberta members within their assigned age group at the Canadian National Junior Squash Championships, as per section 1 above.
 - a) When a player plays "up" in the next age group see note 1 below.
- 3. Ranking will be determined by Squash Alberta Rankings effective the start date of the Canadian National Junior Championships.
- 4. Funding will equal \$150-\$200 per player, depending on the total number of eligible players being considered for funding.

Exemptions: No exemptions or appeals will be considered in determining the eligibility for junior funding as outlined in this policy.

Note 1. If a player competes in another age group, funding will be based on their assigned age group. (i.e., A 14-year-old plays in the U17 division: funding will be based on their ranking amongst the age assigned U15 division players)
