

POLICY

On Court Towel Policy (New Oct 27 2023)

Definitions

1. The following terms have this meaning in this Policy:
 - a. *“player”* – any individual participating in a Squash Alberta sanctioned match.
 - b. *“Towel”* – any item brought on to the court for the purpose of wiping sweat from a player. This excludes sweat bands (head/wrist) worn by a player which are considered as part of their equipment.
 - c. *“Squash Alberta sanctioned match play”* – includes all matches played during Squash Alberta sanctioned league play including ESL (Edmonton Squash League), CISL (Calgary Interclub Squash League), GPSQL (Grande Prairie Squash Club League), all squash leagues in Alberta that require a current Squash Alberta membership to participate in and all Squash Alberta sanctioned tournaments.

Purpose

2. The purpose of this Policy is to describe Squash Alberta’s on court towel policy and use.

Scope and Application

3. This policy applies to all players during all Squash Alberta sanctioned events.

Policy Statement

4. Towels are not permitted on court for individual use during Squash Alberta sanctioned match play.

Appeals

5. Any decision made in accordance with this Policy is not appealable in accordance with Squash Alberta’s Appeal Policy.
