**TRANSFER REGULATIONS**

A successful transfer application must contain the following:

1. Parent's or Guardian's signature;
2. Player's signature if player is 18 years or older;
3. Approval of League/Region in which the player resides; and
4. Approval of League/Region to which the player is applying to transfer.

**PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:**

- (a) No transfer fees are permitted to be imposed in minor baseball.
- (b) Before consideration of granting a release to any player, said player must have registered at their home center (community club, town or region).
- (c) Player has right to request the Vice-President, Competition, or a Sub-Committee of Competition established by the Vice-President, to review and, in his or their absolute discretion, reverse any decision to deny a transfer application.

**ALSO NOTE: All transfers must be requested, attained and approved annually.**

**PROCESSING OF TRANSFER FORMS**

1. Player shall request a release form from league/region he/she last was a member of or obtain a form from the Baseball Manitoba website and complete the required information. Player must then forward the form to the League/Region from which the player wishes to transfer (Transferring League/Region).
2. Transferring League/Region shall review and approve or deny the transfer request. If denied, the transfer form must be returned to the player with an explanation as to why it was denied and a copy must also be forwarded to Baseball Manitoba. If approved, the transfer form must be completed and forwarded to the League/Region to which the player is applying to be transferred (Accepting League/Region) for completion. A copy must also be forwarded to Baseball Manitoba.
3. Accepting League/Region shall review and approve or deny the transfer request. If denied, the transfer form must be returned to the Transferring League/Region with an explanation as to why it was denied. If approved, the form must be completed accordingly and, in either case of approval or denial, the Transferring League/Region shall provide a copy of the form to the player and a copy must also be forwarded to Baseball Manitoba.
4. Baseball Manitoba Executive Director shall advise the region/leagues of decisions by email.
