

Carillon Parents Responsibility Form

Parents,

The Carillon Minor Baseball Association and your local baseball association are happy to be able to offer a baseball program this season. In order for this to happen safely there are a number of guidelines to be followed to fit the requirements set forth by the Province of Manitoba and Baseball Manitoba. We will need a high level of parental support to be able to fulfill these requirements and provide as safe an environment as possible for our players and volunteers. It is important to remember that the guidelines are strict in order to do our best to ensure a safe environment for all stakeholders.

Please read and acknowledge your acceptance to the expectations below for the 2020 baseball season. These are expectations for any practices, games, or related team activities. This form must be signed and returned to your local association prior to participation of your son/daughter in baseball activities.

I will ensure:

- That my son/daughter will not attend baseball activities if they are displaying any illness symptoms (ie. cough, fever, etc.)
- That my son/daughter will not attend baseball activities if they have been in contact with individuals showing symptoms of illness.
- That my son/daughter will be aware of the importance of maintaining social distancing (staying 6 feet away from others) during activities as much as possible.
- That my son/daughter will bring their own labelled water bottle and be aware of the importance of not sharing their bottle or using other players water bottles.
- That my son/daughter will not bring sunflower seeds, gum, candy or any food to baseball activities.
- That my son/daughter will be aware of the importance of not sharing any of their equipment with other players. This includes hats, sunglasses, helmets, bats, gloves, etc.
- That my son/daughter will wear clean clothing to baseball activities (ie. uniforms, pants washed after each practice, game).
- That my son/daughter will supply his/her own helmet and glove.
- Parents, siblings, grandparents or any spectators watching our son/daughter will be made aware and follow social distance rules when in attendance of any baseball activities. (games, practices, etc.)
- Parents, siblings, grandparents or any spectators watching our son/daughter will be made aware of and follow any rules put in place by the facility manager (ie. Recreation Board, Rural Municipality, Baseball Mb.) when in attendance of any baseball activities. (games, practices, etc.)

I am aware that:

- The safest alternative for bats is for my son/daughter to have his/her own bat. If my son/daughter needs to use a team bat, I am aware that there is higher level of risk involved (even if disinfecting occurs between uses).
- The volunteers will have a lot of responsibilities in following the guidelines set forth by the Province of Manitoba and Baseball Manitoba and there is a possibility that some of these expectations may go unnoticed due to the amount of activity in a game or practice.
- There is still a level of risk involved in my child being involved in the baseball activities being offered and that there is a chance of my son/daughter contracting COVID 19 or other viruses while being involved in these activities.
