



2026 U11C District 7 Jamboree Rules

READ THOROUGHLY

These rules will be followed during this tournament, and it is the head coach's responsibility to read them and forward them to the assistant coaches.

1. All tournaments are governed in order by:
 - a. SSWRMSA Tournament Rules
 - b. Softball Canada Rules
2. **Anyone warming up a pitcher in the vicinity of the diamond MUST wear a catcher's mask. A fielder's mask or a helmet with batting cages is NOT acceptable. Failure to do so after a warning is given will result in the individual being removed from the game. If a continuous warning is issued within the same tournament, the Head Coach will be removed from the game.**
3. No pick-ups will be allowed for the tournament unless your roster is less than 9 players. Max is 2 pick-ups, and the roster max is 13 players.
4. **Paper ROSTERS- MUST BE HANDED IN 30 mins**
5. The home team is determined at the start of each Round Robin game by a coin toss.
6. Time starts at the end of the plate conference
7. Pitching max is 2 innings per game (limit suspended during International play/extra innings)
8. All teams must supply an official scorekeeper and agree on the final score before submission to the tournament table
9. **Coaching pitching will not be allowed at any time.** Pitcher will pitch 2 innings.
10. Coaches
 - a. No denim, tank tops, or open-toe shoes or sandals to be worn when on the field when coaching.
 - b. Offence coaches must stay in their "coaches' box."
11. No player will sit out more than 1 consecutive inning, and can not play the same position more than 2 innings per game
12. **The winning team will submit an official score sheet to the tournament table right after scores are confirmed and signatures from both scorekeepers at the end of each game. Including playoffs**
13. Courtesy Runner for the catcher at 2 outs if she is catching the next inning.
14. MVP shirts- A player can only earn 1 MVP shirt
15. **Round Robin Games - 75 mins 4 run max. No new inning after 75 minutes.**
16. **Game ends:**
 - a. Time has expired, and the inning is completed
 - b. Time expired, the visiting team completed their bat, and the home team is ahead and takes the lead.
 - c. The game ends as soon as the home team takes the lead; they do not complete their bats after the winning run is scored

17. Mercy limits

- a. 12 runs after 3 innings
- b. 10 runs after 3 ½ or 4 innings
- c. 7 runs after 4 ½, 5, 5 ½, or 6 innings.

18. Stealing

- a. Base runner may steal on any legally pitched ball once it has left the pitcher's hand
- b. A player can only advance one base on steal attempt
- c. No stealing home. Runner must be batted in or force on a walk to advance
- d. On overthrown balls, a player can steal 1 base
- e. Stealing is allowed

19. Scoring

- a. Points are awarded as follows:
 - i. 2 pts for a win
 - ii. 1 pt for a tie
 - iii. 0 pts for loss
- b. Run differential will be counted to a maximum of +7 and minimum of -7
- c. Bases touched will not be used in the tournament

20. Seeding for playoffs will be determined in order of:

- a. Points, run differential, least runs against, most runs for
- b. In the event of a tie, head-to-head play will be used
- c. If still a tie, a coin toss will be used to break the tie.

21. Playoffs: 75 mins 4 runs max. No new inning after 75 mins.

- a. The highest-seeded team will determine home or away
 - i. Gold Medal Game: The undefeated team will have their choice of home or visitor and will take the appropriate dugouts
- b. In the event of a tie during the playoffs, the international rule will come into effect after the time expires or at the start of the 7th inning and will continue until a winner is determined.
- c. The mercy rule is the same as above.

22. There will be no tolerance for any kind of abuse towards our umpires. This goes towards the coaches, players, guests, and spectators, and at the discretion of the umpire, those individuals may be asked to leave the park for the remainder of the tournament.

23. This is a no-protest tournament, and it's about giving the young girls a positive experience. If you have questions or concerns, please see our UIC, and they will discuss them with you in a polite manner.

24. After the end of each game, it is the **responsibility of the teams** to make sure the dugouts and bleachers are clean of any garbage and water bottles.

25. Remember, at the end of the day, this is about making wonderful memories for these young players and giving them the best experience on and off the field.
