

Capacity for spectators in City of St. Albert arenas are as follows:

- Go Auto, Mark Messier and Jarome Iginla = 100 (two spectators per player)
- Kinex = 50, Troy Murray = 40 (one spectator per player)

Players and Coach Expectations

- Face coverings must be worn in public and common areas, including change rooms, hallways, and the mezzanine.
- Face coverings are mandatory in the dressing room by coaches and players (until helmet is on) regardless of a 'sport cohort status'.
- Face coverings are mandatory for all coaches on the benches. No exceptions.
- There are **NO indoor dryland training/team warm-ups** at this time (including the track). The only indoor option would be to book and pay for space on a FH or Gym Court.
- Teams/groups should be arriving no earlier than 30 minutes prior to their booking and go directly to the dressing rooms. This includes those coming for games. Participants are encouraged to come dressed for their activity, especially those who are unable to dress independently.
- Team must leave the dressing room no later than 15 minutes after end of ice time.
- Tracking of attendance of each ice session needs to be kept

Spectator Expectations

- Spectators need to be aware of the facility capacities and plan accordingly.
- Spectators need to wear a mask at all times.
- Avoid any congregation in the facility. Spectators should enter the facility at the time of the booking and go directly to spectator seating; at the end of the booking time they need to exit the facility. If they are waiting for their children, they must do so outside or in their vehicles. We ask that people do not stand and wait on the mezzanine or foyer areas.
