2018-19 INAUGURAL SEASON



2019-20 HSL SEASON HIGHLIGHTS

The Stars iced three very successful teams this past season with ages ranging from 2009 to 2005 born players. U-14 Varsity, 2007 Major and 2008 Minor. Each team participated in approximately 90 hours of development including a preseason conditioning camp. The U-14 and 2007 teams participated in IIHF checking divisions which included an HSL ran checking clinic in a safe learning environment prior to the start of the season. - Athletes in the minor divisions will participate in a minimum of 75 hours of development provided by their team coach, skills coaches and off ice trainers
- Coaching will include the Academy's Technical Director for consistent skill development and coach mentoring
- Formal goalie instruction from a qualified goalie instructor 10 hours supplied (or \$500 credit – must be enrolled in goalie specific training to receive the credit)
- Players will receive an apparel package including Stars branded academy tracksuit, water bottle and HSL branded warm-up gear
- Each team will compete in 32 regular season league games that will take place in a showcase style format (4 games per weekend)
- > The end of the regular season will culminate with a final HSL Championship Weekend Tournament






U-14 VARSITY MINOR (IIHF BODY CONTACT)

- Athletes will participate in approximately 90 hours of development provided by the head coach, skills coaches, off ice trainers and an HSL ran checking clinic which takes place prior to the season
- Athletes listed on Elite Prospects Website, Major Junior and Junior A Scouts in attendance at select showcases
- As a very important year for 2007 players preparing for the Bantam draft in 2022, the Varsity Team will be head coached by Tyler Waycott (Academy Technical Director). Similarly, for elite 2008 players looking to compete in IIHF Body contact, the U-14 program will provide an extra year of developing this important skill
- Families residing outside of the general Rocky View area can choose to opt out of dryland conditioning (\$200 credit – must be enrolled in local training to receive credit)
- Formal goalie instruction from a qualified goalie instructor 15 hours supplied (or \$800 credit - must be enrolled in goalie specific training to receive the credit)
- Players will receive an apparel package including Stars branded academy jacket and HSL branded warm-up gear
- Each team will compete in 32 regular season league games that will take place in a showcase style format (4 games per weekend)

\$3450 PER PLAYER

Payment Plans up to 9 Months!

- Athletes will participate in approximately 90 hours of development provided by their team-paid coach, skills coaches, off ice trainers and an HSL ran checking clinic which takes place prior to the season
- Advanced player promotion with athletes listed on Elite Prospects Website, Major Junior and Junior A Scouts in attendance at select showcases and Hockey Super League YouTube Channel Exposure
- Paid head coach under the direction of the Academy's Technical Director for consistent skill development and coach mentoring
- Families residing outside of the general Rocky View area can choose to opt out of dryland conditioning (\$200 credit – must be enrolled in local training to receive credit)
- Formal goalie instruction from a qualified goalie instructor 15 hours supplied (or \$800 credit - must be enrolled in goalie specific training to receive the credit)
- Players will receive an apparel package including Stars branded academy jacket and HSL branded warm-up gear
- Each team will compete in 32 regular season league games that will take place in a showcase style format (4 games per weekend
- > The end of the regular season will culminate with a final HSL Championship Weekend Tournament
- U15 Prep Major will be invited to an International Invitational tournament pending HSL approval, to showcase athletes for Major Junior scouts as the eligible players move towards the 2020 Western Hockey League Bantam Draft (2006 born athletes are eligible for the draft)
