SCSA CODE OF CONDUCT for PLAYERS

All players must observe the principles of fair play and respect all others involved in the game, including opponents, spectators and officials.

Therefore, a player should:

- 1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of fellow players, coaches, officials and spectators.
- 2. Respect the talent, potential and development of fellow players and competitors.
- 3. Care for and respect the equipment provided to you as part of your program.
- 4. Be frank and honest with your coach concerning illness and injury and your ability to train fully within the program requirements.
- 5. Conduct yourself in a responsible manner relating to language, temper and punctuality.
- 6. Abide by the rules and Laws of the Game, and respect the decision of the game officials.
- 7. Be honest in your attitude and preparation to training. Work equally hard for yourself and your team.
- 8. Cooperate with coaches and staff in development of programs to adequately prepare you for competition.
- 9. Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit, not just to please parents and coaches
