Start their playoff series against Camrose this coming weekend, because there are no U11 Provincials, this series will be the last of the season.

U13 – Played hard against 3 C's over the weekend. Goalie had her first shutout which gave Stettler the big win – earning them the RMFL division banner. Headed to Lethbridge for best-of-3 series to determine Tier Champ.

The win cinched the ladies a spot in Provincials hosted by Lethbridge Mar 23-26, 2023 **U15** – Team is done for the season and had a nice wind up. Just need to get the bank reconciliation into Martyne.

U18 – Finished 1st in their league. They had a bye for first round of playoffs and beat Camrose in 2nd round. They qualify for Provincials in Airdrie March 31, 2023. They will play Okotoks next weekend to determine who goes as the division champ and who will go as the wild card.

U9 Directors report:

Tournament

SMHA U9 tournament had 18 teams on Blue ice. Fun hockey had 4 teams on red ice. Both set up raffle tables in the lobby. We worked with Center Ice to provide hot dogs, a snack and a juice box to every player using coupons at a tournament cost of \$5/player. Center Ice did their best business of the year during our tournament and will be offering this option to future tournaments.

The Tournament, as a whole, went well. Many compliments. Tournament has a net income of \$7200 after SMHA payment and an estimated ice fee.

Tournament Proceeds

U9 will be refunding all its cash calls this year and will be left with a net profit of \$2700 pending a final reconciliation. In speaking with Joel, he and I both intend to be back next year for U9 and we'd like to make strategic choices with the money we've raised. Our goal would be to purchase equipment or training that will benefit the program in the long run. Is there any issue with us spending this money over the summer?

Wrap Up

We had our year end party after our Saturday morning skates at the end of February. We ordered 200 blokes donuts, got 100 juice boxes, and Centre Ice donated coffee. We encouraged all parents and siblings to come up to the meeting room and join and they almost did get through all the donuts! 170 would have been the perfect amount but we sent extras home with our SMHA families to power up their big kids who played later in the day.

As this year has wrapped up we have begun to think of next year.

Travel Team

In speaking to parents, there is still a lot of interest in a travel team. While the last 2 years have been unsuccessful, we believe some of this is due to communication methods (I sent emails from my personal email this year and they went to junk) and the pandemic. Depending on registration numbers next year, we'd like to table this in September.

Girls Tournament

A few girl moms have approached me about taking our girls as a team on the road to one all girls tournament next year. If done, this would need to be equitable to all genders playing hockey. It could also only be done if there is NO travel team. I feel we can run an inter-house tournament for our boys

on the same weekend the girls are away. We would need to disperse players to make 4 teams and they could play for a candy cup (can we score keep?). This can be tabled till September as well.

Away Tournaments

Feedback has been that families want an opportunity to play two away tournaments. We recommend for the 23/24 season that teams that decide to pursue two tournaments next year would have an increased cash call and the decision and booking of the tournaments would need to be done by a certain deadline. We would require the manager to take a vote with 90% agreement for the team to attend a second tournament.
