

SBA REFUND POLICY

Refund of Fees: Refunds for players withdrawing from the program will be paid, upon written application to the Executive Director or President, less a \$50.00 service charge fee, according to the following schedule:

- 1. Players suspended or expelled for disciplinary reasons shall be ineligible for a refund of fees.
- 2. Executive Director and Treasurer in joint are charged with the responsibility of using reasonable discretion with respect to portioned months.
- For players withdrawing as a result of personal injury or illness, a refund may be provided subject to receipt of a medical certificate from a doctor, the refund will be effective upon the later of, the receipt of the medical certificate or request for refund due to medical reasons.
- 4. Refunds will be prorated based upon the number of game/practice weeks remaining in the season, not withstanding the dates as determined below.
- 5. If requested before the start of the season, registration fees will be refunded in full. Start of the season is defined as when the child has been placed on a team and the child or guardian have been informed by the coach or coordinator of the first practice.
- 6. No refunds will be allowed after November 1, with the exception of refunds due to medical reasons, which will not be allowed after January 15th.
- Because players that make their senior varsity high school teams are no longer eligible for community basketball (ASAA ruling), they may, upon written request, receive 50% of registration fees paid. This needs to be completed by December 31st.
- 8. Credit card payments: If fees are paid by credit card, refunds do NOT include the credit card fee charged.
