7:20 to 7:40 (At stations) Practice
7:40 to 7:45 (Wrap up talk)

- The (Sr.) Will be 9 or 10 players per team, with Practice Tuesday run as per coaches discretion & Games Thursday 6:15 to 7:45 (West diamond) (electric machine pitch week 1, machine pitch week 2-3, coach pitch week 4-5, & player pitch over the season)
- Also Sr. Teams may have Games with other towns (Wed. nite) Home or away
- Top 14 players picked by evaluators (the last 4 Picks to be done by the Sr. coaches and the Director, this will help ensure players are in correct tier)
- **Note: 2021 change:
 - -Coach instruction on April 27, this will insure we all coaches are on same page and practice time is run in fair, fun & productive matter.
 - -The Sr. Team will be using Real Balls for portions of the season;
