Disclaimers

- This policy only applies to U11, U13, U15 and U17 (parody B).
- If an athlete and family have applied for this, it does not mean Strathmore Venom must honor the request if the evaluation committee does not feel the requirements have been met.
- Just because this absenteeism policy has been applied to the situation does not mean the player is guaranteed to make the "B" level, and the player may remain on "C"
- If rosters of each team at the age level are at the maximum allowable limit (18 runners and 2 goalies), this policy becomes irrelevant, and players will be placed at the "C" level.
- The fee for applying this policy is \$100.00 per athlete. \$50.00 is non-refundable should the application be rejected. The fee must be paid in full prior to the evaluation committee's suggested date.
- If the suggested evaluation date cannot be attended by the athlete, this policy will not be applied, and the player will remain on the "C" level.
- Absentee requests must be made within 72 hours of a known conflict. However, players can apply under extenuating circumstances, such as late registration.

	3.0. How to Apply this policy
	3.1. Method of application will be via email with the subject line of (name of player) - (age group) - excused absentee Email registrar@strathmorelacrosse.com with the reasoning and supporting documentation for the scenario. The more documentation provided, the greater the likelihood of approval. This will then be forwarded to the evaluation committee.

	<p>3.2. Application will be reviewed within 5 days upon receipt of payment and application. Payment of \$100.00 must be provided before the date, or no evaluation will be completed. \$50.00 will be non-refundable if rejected. The fee will be paid via e-transfer with the athlete's name and absentee in subject notes and age group. Paid to treasurer at treasurer@strathmorelacrosse.com</p>
	<p>3.3. Once payment is received, a date will be decided on for the evaluation.</p>
	<p>3.4. Once the evaluation is completed, the Strathmore Lacrosse evaluation committee will review the results and inform parents of the evaluation committee's decision regarding player placement. ALL DECISIONS ARE FINAL.</p>
