## Tournament Location:

Strathmore Family Centre (Gold and Blue Arenas) – 160 Brent Blvd, Strathmore AB.

#### Team Check-In:

On Friday each team must check in with the Registration desk, located in the Blue office upstairs at the family centre. (Please note, I would highly recommend printing off roster labels to make the process of filling out game sheets easier, we do not need them early but if the teams can arrive with lots of time to complete this process]). We will have a welcome package for each team as well as game sheets and Player of the Game awards for the first round of games. *Prior to each game*, teams will check in for game sheets and Player of the Game awards.

#### Tournament Information:

Our Tournament will be centered at the Family Centre arena with *CHEX Sports* being our store front on the main floor (They will have stringers with them). Registration and Tournament committee is located on the second floor- Blue Meeting room. The Concourse on the second floor will display our Raffle prizes, apparel for purchase, Coloring contest, Concession and Hired Gun Photography. We will have *a progressive 50/50* draw over the weekend. Tickets will be sold online, find our QR code throughout the building to purchase your winning ticket. The winner will be posted onsite and on our Facebook page/Website. We will accept cash, debit, Visa, and MasterCard for any purchases for our raffle prizes, apparel, and candy table.

Local vendor <u>Bean Dreamin' - Coffee with Character</u> will be parked in the parking lot on Friday and Sunday for your option to purchase hot or cold speciality drinks.

Kona Ice will be onsite on Saturday to offer up some premium shaved ice drinks.

<u>Hired Gun Photography</u> will be on site on Saturday and Sunday providing options for game-action shots and team banner photos. Team banner photos will be taking place on Saturday afternoon. Each player is responsible for any costs associated with photos.

<u>Chicken poop BINGO</u> will be set up outside the front doors of the arena beginning Saturday morning at 10:00 AM with the final ticket sales ending at 4:00 PM on Saturday or sooner if the board fills up. Tickets are \$5.00 each square.
