What is the RAMP Team App?

St. Thomas Ringette will be using the RAMP Team App as a tool for managing teams and team communications. The app allows you to have direct access to game and practice schedules and provides you with the ability to communicate (via chat) with players and coaches. Bond Cheques & Volunteer Hours

All players must provide a **\$200 bond cheque post-dated to March 31, 2024** before the start of their first practice. A table will be set up at the Joe Thorton arena on Tuesday, Sept 12th to collect cheques.
