Bingo FAQ – 2022-2023

1. How many bingos am I required to work?
 - a. Bronze Package - 0
 - b. Silver Package – Min 3
 - c. Gold Package – Min 3
 - d. A Gold or Silver package may choose to fill all their volunteer commitment with Bingo shifts
2. How do I contact the bingo coordinator?
 - a. Contact Rita Purdy (ritz)
3. Where do I go to work a bingo? (Location determined when you pick a date to work)
 - a. Castledowns Bingo 12222 137 Ave NW, Edmonton, AB T5L 4X5
 - b. Parkway Bingo 8775 51 Ave NW, Edmonton, AB T6E 5H1
4. Can I work extra bingos to offset my costs?
 - a. Number of Potential additional bingos is subject to availability
 - b. Maximum number of potential additional bingos also depends on program
5. What happens if I am unable to work a bingo that I signed up for?
 - a. You need to contact the Bingo Coordinator AND find a replacement person to cover the bingo for you.
 - b. If you are unable to find a replacement worker you will be fined by the club and are responsible for any fees/penalties levied by the bingo hall.
6. When should I sign up for all of my bingos for the year?
 - a. As soon as possible as it helps to plan for which bingos we are able to commit to as a club
 - b. Many of the bingos are during the Monday to Friday week. Planning ahead will mean that weekend bingos are still available.
7. How many bingos do I need to work to cover the cost of a Mountain Camp?
 - a. The number of camps required to cover any potential additional programming in the 2022-2023 season will be communicated if available when these races or camps are made available.
8. How long are each bingo shift?
 - a. Each bingo shift is from 4:30pm to 12am, with a break for dinner
