## How to print your Fitness Tax Receipt

1. Log into your RAMP online account using the following link:

<https://apps.rampinteractive.com/registrations/v3/?c=4df188c8058c>

Use the email account and password used to register your child(ren).

2. On the resulting account “Dashboard Home screen”, click on the “Children’s Fitness Tax Credit” on the left hand “Account Menu” section. See the below screen shot:

## Children's Fitness Tax Credit

Starting with the 2007 tax year, the Government of Canada allows a non-refundable tax credit based on eligible child fitness expenses paid up to \$500 per child by parents to register a child in a prescribed program of physical activity.

The children's fitness tax credit lets parents claim up to \$500 per year for eligible fitness expenses paid for each child who is under 16 years of age at the beginning of the year in which the expenses are paid.

3. You will be eligible for the amount paid up to a maximum of the eligible tax amount for the package.
